

Learn to fringe twist


fringe twist yarn and fibre




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Fringe twister




Make a perfect twisted fringe on scarves, handwoven garments or needlework projects. Create cording from cotton or twist sliver for fibre craft projects. Add beads and metallics for texture and fun.




FRINGE TWISTING YARN

Clamp fringe twister to a table.




Divide into groups of desired thickness.

Hint: Usually 4-6 wool strands or 6-8 cotton.




Place a hand on the garment to keep tension on the stands clipped to the twister, turn the handle clockwise as many times as desired (take note of how many rotations, and repeat across fringe, this will ensure an even twist and length).



To ply, remove from clips and finish by knotting the two halves together close to the end. The two halves will twist anticlockwise to create the fringe.


Repeat from step 1. working along the garment.

For an optional knotless fringe on wool fabrics, semi-felt the twisted fringes by applying soap and warm water to a few fringes at a time, rubbing back and forth between your palms. Wash fabric as normal, then trim the knotted ends off. Using a rotary cutter and ruler to get perfect even fringes.




FRINGE TWISTING FIBRE


Clamp fringe twister to a table.
Divide fibre/sliver into even desired thicknesses. Clip each length in place.



Place a hand on the ends of the sliver and rotate the handle clockwise until the fibre/sliver is twisted.



Holding onto the ends, unclip and place all 4 opposite ends into one clip and rotate anti-clockwise.



Tie a knot in each end to secure.

Hints:

- Twisted fibre/sliver can be felted by hand or in your washing machine.
- If handle squeaks, apply a drop of oil to the shafts.
- Hold handle in the centre, pull away and turn gently.

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
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
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


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
